SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4620

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 3406aa.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3406aa. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, or renews in this state a health insurance policy shall not limit or exclude coverage for an individual by imposing a preexisting condition exclusion on the individual.
 - (2) This section does not apply to any of the following:
- 6 (a) Grandfathered health plan coverage, as that term is 7 defined in 45 CFR 147.140.
- 8 (b) Insurance coverage that provides benefits for any of the 9 following:



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- 1 (i) Hospital confinement indemnity.
- 2 (ii) Disability income.
- 3 (iii) Accident only.
- 4 (iv) Long-term care.
- 5 (v) Medicare supplemental.
- 6 (vi) Limited benefit health.
- 7 (vii) Specified disease indemnity.
- 8 (viii) Sickness or bodily injury, or death by accident, or both.
- 9 (ix) Retiree-only health insurance coverage.
- 10 (x) Stand-alone dental plans.
- 11 (xi) Stand-alone vision plans.
- 12 (xii) Other limited benefit policies.
- 13 (3) As used in this section, "preexisting condition exclusion"
- 14 means a limitation or exclusion of benefits or a denial of coverage
- 15 based on the fact that a physical or mental condition was present
- 16 before the effective date of coverage or before the date coverage
- 17 is denied, whether or not any medical advice, diagnosis, care, or
- 18 treatment was recommended or received for the condition before the
- 19 date of coverage or denial of coverage.
