SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 169

A bill to amend 1947 PA 336, entitled

"An act to prohibit strikes by certain public employees; to provide review from disciplinary action with respect thereto; to provide for the mediation of grievances and the holding of elections; to declare and protect the rights and privileges of public employees; to require certain provisions in collective bargaining agreements; to prescribe means of enforcement and penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to make appropriations,"

(MCL 423.201 to 423.217) by adding section 11a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 11a. (1) Not later than 30 days after a public employer
- 2 hires a public employee, the public employer shall provide the
- 3 employment and contact information of the public employee to the
- 4 representative of the public employee described in section 11.
- 5 Every 90 days, a public employer shall provide to each

- 1 representative of its public employees the employment and contact
- 2 information of the public employees represented by that
- 3 representative.
- 4 (2) The employment and contact information provided under
- 5 subsection (1) must include all of the following for each public
- 6 employee:
- 7 (a) First, middle, and last name.
- 8 (b) Department or agency.
- 9 (c) Classification.
- 10 (d) Address of primary work location.
- 11 (e) Home address. However, if the public employee's home
- 12 address is a confidential address, the public employer shall not
- 13 provide the home address of the public employee and shall instead
- 14 provide the public employee's designated address. As used in this
- 15 subdivision:
- 16 (i) "Confidential address" means that term as defined in
- 17 section 3 of the address confidentiality program act, 2020 PA 301,
- 18 MCL 780.853.
- 19 (ii) "Designated address" means that term as defined in section
- 20 3 of the address confidentiality program act, 2020 PA 301, MCL
- 21 780.853.
- 22 (f) Personal telephone number.
- 23 (g) Personal email address.
- 24 (h) Work email address.
- 25 (i) Date of hire.
- 26 (j) Employee identification number, if applicable.
- (k) Full-time or part-time employment status.
- 28 (l) Wage.
- 29 (3) Before a public employer enters into an agreement

- 1 described in section 10(5), the public employer shall inform each
- 2 of its public employees to whom the agreement would apply that the
- 3 public employer intends to enter into the agreement. If a public
- 4 employer has entered into an agreement described in section 10(5)
- 5 that is in effect or has yet to take effect, the public employer
- 6 shall, before the public employer hires an individual as a public
- 7 employee to whom the agreement would apply, inform the individual
- 8 that the public employer has entered into an agreement described in
- 9 section 10(5) that would apply to the individual.
