A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4957 AS REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE

The bill would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate the bridge on Highway US-2 over the Cut River in Mackinac County as the "Heath Michael Robinson Cut River Memorial Bridge."

Proposed MCL 250.1068

FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 2 of the Michigan Memorial Highway Act indicates that the State Transportation Department shall only provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of the highway "when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting and maintaining those markers." As a result, the bill has no state or local fiscal impact.
