## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4155

## A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5e (MCL 28.425e), as added by 2000 PA 381.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5e. (1) The department of state police shall create and
- 2 maintain a computerized database of individuals who apply under
- 3 this act for a license to carry a concealed pistol. The database
- 4 shall contain only the following information as to each individual:

- 1 (a) The individual's name, date of birth, address, and county
- 2 of residence.
- 3 (b) If the individual is licensed to carry a concealed pistol
- 4 in this state, the license number and date of expiration.
- 5 (c) Except as provided in subsection (2), if the individual
- 6 was denied a license to carry a concealed pistol after the
- 7 effective date of the amendatory act that added this subdivision,
- 8 JULY 1, 2001, a statement of the reasons for that denial.
- 9 (d) A statement of all criminal charges pending and criminal
- 10 convictions obtained against the individual during the license
- 11 period.
- 12 (e) A statement of all determinations of responsibility for
- 13 civil infractions of this act pending or obtained against the
- 14 individual during the license period.
- 15 (2) If an individual who was denied a license to carry a
- 16 concealed pistol after the effective date of the amendatory act
- 17 that added this subsection JULY 1, 2001 is subsequently issued a
- 18 license to carry a concealed pistol, the department of state police
- 19 shall delete from the computerized database the previous reasons
- 20 for the denial.
- 21 (3) The department of state police shall enter the information
- 22 described in subsection (1)(a) and (b) into the law enforcement
- 23 information network.
- 24 (4) Information in the database , compiled under subsections
- 25 (1) through (3), is confidential, is not subject to disclosure
- 26 under the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to
- 27 15.246, and shall not be disclosed to any person except for

- 1 purposes of this act or for law enforcement purposes. The
- 2 information compiled under subsection (5) is subject to disclosure
- 3 under the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to
- 4 15.246. SHALL ONLY BE ACCESSED AND DISCLOSED ACCORDING TO AN ACCESS
- 5 PROTOCOL THAT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 6 (A) THAT THE REQUESTOR OF THE FIREARMS RECORDS USES THE LAW
- 7 ENFORCEMENT INFORMATION NETWORK OR ANOTHER SYSTEM THAT MAINTAINS A
- 8 RECORD OF THE REQUESTOR'S IDENTITY, TIME, AND DATE THAT THE REQUEST
- 9 WAS MADE.
- 10 (B) REQUIRES THE REQUESTOR IN AN INTENTIONAL QUERY BY NAME OF
- 11 THE FIREARMS RECORDS TO ATTEST THAT THE FIREARMS RECORDS WERE
- 12 SOUGHT UNDER 1 OF THE LAWFUL PURPOSES PROVIDED IN SECTION 1B(2).
- 13 (5) The department of state police shall file an annual report
- 14 with the secretary of the senate and the clerk of the house of
- 15 representatives, AND POST ON THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE'S
- 16 INTERNET WEBSITE, AN ANNUAL REPORT setting forth all of the
- 17 following information for each county concealed weapon licensing
- 18 board:
- 19 (a) The number of concealed pistol applications received.
- 20 (b) The number of concealed pistol licenses issued.
- 21 (c) The number of concealed pistol licenses denied.
- (d) Categories for denial under subdivision (c).
- (e) The number of concealed pistol licenses revoked.
- 24 (f) Categories for revocation under subdivision (e).
- 25 (g) The number of applications pending at the time the report
- 26 is made.
- (h) The mean and median amount of time and the longest and

- 1 shortest amount of time used by the federal bureau of investigation
- 2 to supply the fingerprint comparison report required in section
- $3 \frac{5b(11)}{5}$ . 5B(10). The department may use a statistically significant
- 4 sample to comply with this subdivision.
- 5 (i) The number of charges of state civil infractions of this
- 6 act or charges of criminal violations, categorized by offense,
- 7 filed against individuals licensed to carry a concealed pistol that
- 8 resulted in a finding of responsibility or a criminal conviction.
- 9 The report shall indicate the number of crimes in each category of
- 10 criminal offense that involved the brandishing or use of a pistol,
- 11 the number that involved the carrying of a pistol by the license
- 12 holder during the commission of the crime, and the number in which
- 13 no pistol was carried by the license holder during the commission
- 14 of the crime.
- 15 (j) The number of pending criminal charges, categorized by
- 16 offense, against individuals licensed to carry a concealed pistol.
- 17 (k) The number of criminal cases dismissed, categorized by
- 18 offense, against individuals licensed to carry a concealed pistol.
- 19 (l) The number of cases filed against individuals licensed to
- 20 carry a concealed pistol for criminal violations that resulted in a
- 21 finding of not responsible or not guilty, categorized by offense.
- 22 (m) For the purposes of subdivisions (i), (j), (k), and (l),
- 23 the department of state police shall use the data provided under
- 24 section 5m.
- 25 (n) The number of suicides by individuals licensed to carry a
- 26 concealed pistol.
- (o) Actual costs incurred per permit for each county.

- 1 (P) THE NUMBER OF TIMES THE DATABASE WAS ACCESSED, CATEGORIZED
- 2 BY THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE DATABASE WAS ACCESSED.
- 3 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
- 4 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 5 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 6 unless all of the following bills of the 97th Legislature are
- 7 enacted into law:

- 9 (b) Senate Bill No. 834.
