A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding part 58A.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

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- 2 SUDDEN UNEXPECTED INFANT DEATH EDUCATION AND PREVENTION
  3 SEC. 5881. (1) THIS PART MAY BE REFERRED TO AS THE "SLEEP SAFE
  4 ACT".
  - (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PART, THE WORDS AND PHRASES DEFINED IN SECTIONS 5883 TO 5884 HAVE THE MEANINGS ASCRIBED TO THEM IN THOSE SECTIONS UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE.
    - (3) IN ADDITION, ARTICLE 1 CONTAINS GENERAL DEFINITIONS AND

- 1 PRINCIPLES OF CONSTRUCTION APPLICABLE TO ALL ARTICLES IN THIS ACT.
- 2 SEC. 5883. (1) "HEALTH PROFESSIONAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL
- 3 LICENSED, REGISTERED, CERTIFIED, OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE
- 4 IN A HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER ARTICLE 15.
- 5 (2) "HOSPITAL" MEANS A HOSPITAL LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 17 THAT
- 6 PROVIDES CLINICALLY RELATED HEALTH SERVICES FOR OBSTETRICAL AND
- 7 NEWBORN CARE AND INCLUDES A HOSPITAL OPERATED BY THIS STATE, A
- 8 LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNIT, OR AN AGENCY. HOSPITAL DOES NOT INCLUDE AN
- 9 OFFICE USED PRIMARILY FOR PRIVATE OR GROUP PRACTICE BY HEALTH
- 10 PROFESSIONALS IN WHICH NO REVIEWABLE, CLINICALLY RELATED HEALTH
- 11 SERVICES ARE OFFERED.
- 12 (3) "INFANT" MEANS A CHILD WHO IS 30 DAYS OLD OR OLDER AND WHO
- 13 IS YOUNGER THAN 24 MONTHS OLD.
- 14 (4) "NEWBORN" MEANS A CHILD WHO IS YOUNGER THAN 30 DAYS OLD.
- 15 SEC. 5884. (1) "PARENT" MEANS A NATURAL PARENT, STEPPARENT,
- 16 ADOPTIVE PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN, OR LEGAL CUSTODIAN OF A NEWBORN OR
- 17 INFANT.
- 18 (2) "PARENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT STATEMENT" MEANS THE STATEMENT OF A
- 19 PARENT ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION
- 20 5885(4).
- 21 (3) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE SAFE SLEEP EDUCATION PROGRAM
- 22 ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS PART.
- 23 (4) "SAFE SLEEP VIDEO" MEANS THE SAFE SLEEP VIDEO DESCRIBED IN
- 24 SECTION 5885(3).
- 25 (5) "SUDDEN INFANT DEATH SYNDROME" OR "SIDS" MEANS A SUDDEN
- 26 UNEXPECTED INFANT DEATH THAT REMAINS UNEXPLAINED AFTER THE
- 27 PERFORMANCE OF A COMPLETE POSTMORTEM INVESTIGATION THAT INCLUDES AN

- 1 AUTOPSY, AN EXAMINATION OF THE SCENE OF THE DEATH, AND A REVIEW OF
- 2 THE INFANT'S MEDICAL RECORD.
- 3 (6) "SUDDEN UNEXPECTED INFANT DEATH" OR "SUID" MEANS THE
- 4 SUDDEN UNEXPECTED DEATH OF AN APPARENTLY HEALTHY INFANT.
- 5 SEC. 5885. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A SAFE SLEEP
- 6 EDUCATION PROGRAM TO PROMOTE AWARENESS AND EDUCATION RELATING TO
- 7 SIDS AND SUIDS WITH THE FOCUS ON THE RISK FACTORS OF SIDS AND
- 8 SUIDS AND SAFE SLEEPING PRACTICES FOR NEWBORNS AND INFANTS.
- 9 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT STRATEGIES
- 10 FOR RAISING PUBLIC AWARENESS CONCERNING SUIDS, INCLUDING, BUT
- 11 NOT LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (A) RISK FACTORS FOR SUID, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 13 INFANT SLEEP POSITION, EXPOSURE TO SMOKE, OVERHEATING,
- 14 INAPPROPRIATE INFANT BEDDING, AND BED SHARING.
- 15 (B) SUGGESTIONS FOR REDUCING THE RISK OF SUIDS.
- 16 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE AS PART OF THE PROGRAM THE
- 17 DISTRIBUTION OF READILY UNDERSTANDABLE INFORMATION AND EDUCATIONAL
- 18 AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS REGARDING SUIDS AND SAFE SLEEPING
- 19 PRACTICES. THE MATERIALS DISTRIBUTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MUST
- 20 EXPLAIN THE RISK FACTORS ASSOCIATED WITH SUIDS AND EMPHASIZE SAFE
- 21 SLEEPING PRACTICES. THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
- 22 SERVICES SHALL CREATE AND MAINTAIN A SAFE SLEEP VIDEO THAT INCLUDES
- 23 INFORMATION ON SAFE SLEEPING PRACTICES FOR INCLUSION IN THE
- 24 PROGRAM.
- 25 (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRESCRIBE THE FORM OF A PARENT
- 26 ACKNOWLEDGMENT STATEMENT. THE FORM MUST INCLUDE A PLACE FOR A
- 27 PARENT TO SIGN, ACKNOWLEDGING THAT THE PARENT HAS VIEWED THE SAFE

- 1 SLEEP VIDEO AND HAS RECEIVED, HAS READ, AND HAS AN UNDERSTANDING OF
- 2 THE EDUCATIONAL AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS PROVIDED ON SUID AND
- 3 SAFE SLEEPING PRACTICES.
- 4 SEC. 5886. (1) FOR A BIRTH THAT OCCURS IN A HOSPITAL, THE
- 5 HOSPITAL SHALL PROVIDE THE MATERIALS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 5885(3)
- 6 WITHOUT COST TO A PARENT AFTER THE BIRTH OF THE NEWBORN AND BEFORE
- 7 DISCHARGE FROM THE HOSPITAL. FOR A BIRTH THAT OCCURS IN A SETTING
- 8 OTHER THAN A HOSPITAL, THE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL IN CHARGE OF THE
- 9 CARE OF A NEWBORN, OR IF NONE THE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL IN CHARGE AT
- 10 THE BIRTH OF A NEWBORN, SHALL PROVIDE THE MATERIALS DESCRIBED IN
- 11 SECTION 5885(3) WITHOUT COST TO A PARENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER
- 12 THE BIRTH OF A NEWBORN.
- 13 (2) AFTER RECEIPT OF THE MATERIALS UNDER SUBSECTION (1),
- 14 INCLUDING THE VIEWING OF THE SAFE SLEEP VIDEO, A PARENT SHALL SIGN
- 15 THE PARENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT STATEMENT. THE HOSPITAL OR HEALTH
- 16 PROFESSIONAL, AS APPLICABLE, SHALL PLACE THE SIGNED PARENT
- 17 ACKNOWLEDGMENT STATEMENT IN THE NEWBORN'S PERMANENT MEDICAL RECORD.
- 18 THE HOSPITAL OR HEALTH PROFESSIONAL, AS APPLICABLE, SHALL PROVIDE A
- 19 COPY OF THE SIGNED PARENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT STATEMENT TO THE PARENT
- 20 WHO SIGNED THE STATEMENT.
- 21 (3) A HOSPITAL OR HEALTH PROFESSIONAL THAT COMPLIES WITH THIS
- 22 SECTION IS NOT CRIMINALLY OR CIVILLY LIABLE FOR THE ACTION OR
- 23 INACTION OF A PARENT WITH REGARD TO SAFE SLEEPING PRACTICES FOR A
- 24 NEWBORN OR INFANT PURSUANT TO MATERIALS GIVEN TO THE PARENT UNDER
- 25 THIS SECTION. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE HOSPITAL OR
- 26 HEALTH PROFESSIONAL ENGAGES IN BEHAVIOR THAT INVOLVES GROSS
- 27 NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL OR WANTON MISCONDUCT.

- 1 SEC. 5887. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) WORK TO IMPROVE THE CAPACITY OF COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES
- 3 AVAILABLE TO PARENTS REGARDING THE RISK FACTORS INVOLVED WITH SUID
- 4 AND SAFE SLEEPING PRACTICES FOR NEWBORNS AND INFANTS.
- 5 (B) WORK WITH OTHER STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES,
- 6 COMMUNITY AND BUSINESS LEADERS, COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS, HEALTH
- 7 CARE AND HUMAN SERVICE PROVIDERS, AND NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS TO
- 8 COORDINATE EFFORTS AND MAXIMIZE STATE AND PRIVATE RESOURCES IN THE
- 9 AREAS OF EDUCATION ABOUT SUIDS, INCLUDING THE RISK FACTORS AND SAFE
- 10 SLEEPING PRACTICES.
- 11 (C) IDENTIFY AND, WHEN APPROPRIATE, REPLICATE OR USE
- 12 SUCCESSFUL SUID PROGRAMS AND PROCURE RELATED MATERIALS AND SERVICES
- 13 FROM ORGANIZATIONS WITH APPROPRIATE EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE OF
- 14 SUID.
- 15 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 16 after the date it is enacted into law.
