SENATE BILL No. 888

March 20, 2014, Introduced by Senators HILDENBRAND, MOOLENAAR, SCHUITMAKER, GREGORY, WARREN, NOFS, MARLEAU, KAHN, MEEKHOF and KOWALL and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 218, entitled "Adult foster care facility licensing act," by amending section 10 (MCL 400.710), as amended by 2006 PA 201.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 10. (1) The department shall promulgate rules pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328, in the areas provided under subsection (4).
 - (2) The bureau of fire services created in section 1b of the fire prevention code, 1941 PA 207, MCL 29.1b, shall promulgate rules providing for adequate fire prevention and safety in an adult foster care facility licensed or proposed to be licensed for more

- 1 than 6 adults. The rules shall be promulgated in cooperation with
- 2 the department and the state fire safety board and shall provide
- 3 for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the adults
- 4 residing in a facility. The bureau of fire services shall
- 5 promulgate the rules pursuant to the administrative procedures act
- 6 of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328. A person may request a
- 7 variance from the application of a rule promulgated pursuant to
- 8 this subsection by application to the state fire marshal. The state
- 9 fire marshal may make a variance upon a finding that the variance
- 10 does not result in a hazard to life or property. The finding shall
- 11 be transmitted to the person requesting the variance and shall be

- 6 including cooperation with rights protection systems established by

- 8 (i) Provisions to prescribe the rights of licensees.
- 9 (j) Maintenance of records pertaining to admission, progress,
