## HOUSE BILL NO. 5940

A bill to amend 2011 PA 256, entitled "Michigan fireworks safety act," by amending section 7 (MCL 28.457), as amended by 2013 PA 65.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7. (1) Except as provided in this act, a local unit of
- 2 government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance, code, or
- 3 regulation pertaining to or in any manner regulating the sale,
- 4 display, storage, transportation, or distribution of fireworks
- 5 regulated under this act.
- 6 (2) A local unit of government may enact an ordinance
- 7 regulating the ignition, discharge, and use of consumer fireworks,
- 8 including, but not limited to, an ordinance prescribing the hours
- 9 of the day or night during which a person may ignite, discharge, or
- 10 use consumer fireworks. If a local unit of government enacts an

- 1 ordinance under this subsection, the ordinance shall not regulate
- 2 the ignition, discharge, or use of consumer fireworks on the day
- 3 preceding, the day of, or the day after a national holiday except
- 4 as follows: FOLLOWING DAYS AFTER 11 A.M.:
- 5 (a) A local unit of government with a population of 50,000 or
- 6 more or a local unit of government located in a county with a
- 7 population of 750,000 or more may regulate the ignition, discharge,
- 8 or use of consumer fireworks between the hours of 12 midnight and 8
- 9 a.m. or between the hours of 1 a.m. and 8 a.m. on New Year's day.
- 10 (b) A local unit of government with a population of less than
- 11 50,000 located in a county with a population of less than 750,000
- 12 may regulate the ignition, discharge, or use of consumer fireworks
- 13 between the hours of 1 a.m. and 8 a.m.
- 14 (A) DECEMBER 31 UNTIL 1 A.M. ON JANUARY 1.
- 15 (B) THE SATURDAY AND SUNDAY IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING MEMORIAL DAY
- 16 UNTIL 11:30 P.M. ON EACH OF THOSE DAYS.
- 17 (C) JUNE 29 TO JULY 4 UNTIL 11:30 P.M. ON EACH OF THOSE DAYS.
- 18 (D) JULY 5, IF THAT DATE IS A FRIDAY OR SATURDAY, UNTIL 11:30
- 19 P.M.
- 20 (E) THE SATURDAY AND SUNDAY IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING LABOR DAY
- 21 UNTIL 11:30 P.M. ON EACH OF THOSE DAYS.
- 22 (3) An ordinance under subsection (2) shall only impose a
- 23 civil fine of not more than \$500.00 \$1,000.00 for each violation of
- 24 the ordinance and no other fine or sanction. THE ORDINANCE MUST
- 25 PROVIDE FOR THE REMITTANCE OF \$500.00 OF THE FINE COLLECTED UNDER
- 26 THE ORDINANCE TO THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR
- 27 ENFORCING THE ORDINANCE.

- (4) BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2019, A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT WITH 1
- 2 A POPULATION OF 100,000 OR MORE OR A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT
- LOCATED IN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF 750,000 OR MORE MAY ENACT 3
- 4 OR ENFORCE AN ORDINANCE THAT REGULATES THE USE OF A TEMPORARY
- STRUCTURE. AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY 5
- INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, A RESTRICTION ON THE NUMBER OF 6
- PERMITS ISSUED FOR A TEMPORARY STRUCTURE, REGULATION OF THE 7
- DISTANCE REQUIRED BETWEEN 2 OR MORE TEMPORARY STRUCTURES, OR A 8
- ZONING ORDINANCE THAT REGULATES THE USE OF A TEMPORARY STRUCTURE. 9
- AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT PROHIBIT THE 10
- 11 TEMPORARY STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, OR DISTRIBUTION OF FIREWORKS BY
- 12 A CONSUMER FIREWORKS CERTIFICATE HOLDER AT A RETAIL LOCATION THAT
- 13 IS A PERMANENT BUILDING OR STRUCTURE. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION,
- "TEMPORARY STRUCTURE" MEANS A MOVABLE STRUCTURE THAT IS USED IN THE 14
- SALE, DISPLAY, STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, OR DISTRIBUTION OF 15
- FIREWORKS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A TENT OR A STAND. 16
