HOUSE BILL No. 5209

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding sections 484a and 956a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 484A. AN ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL TO
CIRCULATE OR OBTAIN SIGNATURES ON A BALLOT QUESTION PETITION
PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT, INITIATION OF LEGISLATION, OR
REFERENDUM OF LEGISLATION IF THAT INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF
AN ELECTION CRIME, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ELECTION FRAUD OR
FORGERY.

7 SEC. 956A. AN ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL TO 8 CIRCULATE OR OBTAIN SIGNATURES ON A RECALL PETITION IF THAT 9 INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF AN ELECTION CRIME, INCLUDING, BUT 10 NOT LIMITED TO, ELECTION FRAUD OR FORGERY.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
