## **HOUSE BILL No. 5988**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 80221 (MCL 324.80221), as added by 2000 PA 229.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 80221. Peace officers shall enforce this part. If a person has received a citation for a violation of a certification requirement prescribed in section 80210, 80213 —or 80215, the court shall waive any fine and costs upon receipt, not more than 10 days after the citation is issued, of proof of certification by a law enforcement agency that the person, before the appearance date on the citation, produced a valid boating safety certificate, or other certification described in section 80216, as applicable, AN ELECTRONIC COPY THEREOF, that was valid on the date the violation occurred.
