## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 40111. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3)

or (5), this part, or in a department order authorized under

section 40107, an individual shall not take an animal from in or

upon a vehicle.

(2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (3), (4), or (5), OR (6), this part, or in a department order authorized under section 40107, an individual shall not transport or possess a firearm in or upon a vehicle, unless the firearm is unloaded and enclosed in a case, unloaded and carried in the trunk of a vehicle,

- 1 or unloaded in a motorized boat.
- 2 (3) A person with a disability may transport or possess a
- 3 firearm in or upon a vehicle, except for a car or truck, on a state
- 4 licensed game bird hunting preserve if the firearm is unloaded and
- 5 the vehicle is operated at a speed of not greater than 10 miles per
- 6 hour. A person with a disability may possess a loaded firearm and

- (i) For a bow, that the bow is not in the drawn position.

- 22 SIDE SEATING ARRANGEMENT WITH BENCH OR BUCKET SEATING FOR EACH
- 23 RIDER, AND IS POWERED BY A 50CC TO 1,000CC GASOLINE ENGINE OR AN
- 24 ENGINE OF COMPARABLE SIZE USING OTHER FUELS.
