A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 492a (MCL 168.492a), as amended by 2018 PA 125; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 492a. An individual who is confined in a jail or prison
- 2 and who is otherwise a qualified elector may , before trial or
- 3 sentence, register to vote. The individual is considered a resident
- 4 of the city or township, and address, at which he or she resided

- 1 before confinement. An individual who is confined in a jail after
- 2 being convicted and sentenced is not eligible to register to vote.
- 3 Enacting section 1. Section 758b of the Michigan election law,
- 4 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.758b, is repealed.
