

DIGITAL LITERACY AND CYBERSAFETY INFORMATION

House Bill 4414 as introduced Sponsor: Rep. Helena Scott Committee: Energy, Communications, and Technology Revised 5-15-23

SUMMARY:

House Bill 4414 would amend the Management and Budget Act to require the Department of Technology, Management, and Budget to create materials, resources, model curricula, and lesson plans regarding digital literacy and cybersafety and provide them for free on its website.

Proposed MCL 18.1290

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Department of Technology, Management, and Budget may incur additional costs related to requiring one or more additional staff members and other office resources to create materials and curricula on an ongoing basis. It is not yet known how many additional staff members would be needed to implement the bill. The average annual state classified employee full-time equivalent salary cost is approximately \$115,000. The bill would have no fiscal impact on local units of government.
