## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4621

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

by amending section 3403 (MCL 500.3403), as amended by 2016 PA 276.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3403. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery,
- 2 or renews in this state a health insurance policy that offers makes
- 3 dependent coverage available under the health insurance policy
- 4 shall include both of the following provisions in the policy:
- 5 (a) That do all of the following:
- 6 (a) Make available dependent coverage, at the option of the 7 policyholder, until the dependent has attained 26 years of age.
- 8 (b) Provide the same health insurance benefits to a dependent
- 9 child that are available to any other covered dependent.

- 1 (c) Provide health insurance benefits to a dependent child at 2 the same rate or premium applicable to any other covered dependent.
- 3 (d) Include both of the following provisions in the health 4 insurance policy:
- (i) That the health insurance benefits applicable for children
  are payable with respect to a newly born child of the insured from
  the moment of birth.
- 8 (ii) (b) That the coverage for newly born children consists of
   9 coverage of injury or sickness including the necessary care and
   10 treatment of medically diagnosed congenital defects and birth
   11 abnormalities.
- 12 (2) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery, or renews
  13 in this state a A health insurance policy that offers dependent
  14 coverage shall not deny enrollment to an insured's child on any of
  15 the following grounds:
- 16 (a) The child was born out of wedlock.
- 17 (b) The child is not claimed as a dependent on the insured's18 federal income tax return.
- 19 (c) The child does not reside with the insured or in the
  20 insurer's service area.
- 21 (3) This section does not require an insurer or plan to make 22 coverage available for a child of a child receiving dependent 23 coverage.
