A bill to amend 1919 PA 160, entitled
"An act to release legally married minors from parental control andto determine their marital rights and duties,"
by amending section 1 (MCL 551.251).
THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:
privileges, and such the minor shall be-is subject to the same duties, liabilities, and responsibilities, as such the husband or wife, as if such-the minor husband or wife were of legal age at the time of such-the marriage.
(2) Hereafter it shall be-It is unnecessary in any divorce suit action commenced by or against a legally married minor to have a next friend or guardian ad litem appointed for such that minor unless the eircuit judge shall require it; and such-judge requires it. A minor shall be-is entitled to prosecute or defend any such the action in the same manner and with the same effect as if he or she were of legal age.
