THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 335b. (1) An individual who is 18 years of age or older
- 2 who knowingly transmits, by computer or other electronic means, to
- 3 the computer or electronic communication device of another
- 4 individual who is 18 years of age or older a sexually explicit
- 5 video or image if the recipient has not consented to, or has

- 1 image is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more
- 2 than \$500.00.
- 3 (2) Regardless of the existence or outcome of any criminal
- 4 prosecution under this section, the recipient of a sexually
- 5 explicit video or image transmitted in violation of subsection (1)
- 6 may bring a civil cause of action against the individual who
- 7 commits the offense to secure an injunction, actual damages,
- 8 including damages for emotional distress, or other appropriate
- 9 relief. A plaintiff who prevails in a civil action brought under
- 10 this section may recover both of the following:
