THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3403. (1) An insurer that delivers, issues for delivery,
- 2 or renews in this state a health insurance policy that offers makes
- 3 dependent coverage available under the health insurance policy
- 4 shall include both of the following provisions in the policy:
- 5 (a) That do all of the following:
- 6 (a) Offer the dependent coverage, at the option of the

- 2 (b) Provide the same health insurance benefits to a dependent 3 child that are available to any other covered dependent.
- 4 (c) Provide health insurance benefits to a dependent child at 5 the same rate or premium applicable to any other covered dependent.
 - (d) Include both of the following provisions in the health insurance policy:
- 8 (i) That the health insurance benefits applicable for children
 9 are payable with respect to a newly born child of the insured from
 10 the moment of birth.
- (ii) (b)—That the coverage for newly born children consists of coverage of injury or sickness including the necessary care and treatment of medically diagnosed congenital defects and birth abnormalities.

- 1 disability to the insurer within 30 days after the dependent child
