A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 16279.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 16279. (1) A licensee or registrant who provides an
- 2 individual with prenatal care, postnatal care, or genetic
- 3 counseling shall provide the individual with the written
- 4 information described under subsection (2) at the time the licensee

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- 1 or registrant receives a test result or administers a screening for
- 2 that individual that indicates a high likelihood for or presence of
- 3 Down syndrome in a fetus or neonate of that individual.
- 4 (2) The department of health and human services shall develop
- 5 and make available to licensees and registrants who provide
- 6 individuals with prenatal care, postnatal care, or genetic
- 7 counseling written information on Down syndrome that meets all of
- 8 the following requirements:
- 9 (a) Is reviewed by medical experts.
- 10 (b) Provides all of the following information:
- 11 (i) A clinical course description of Down syndrome, including
- 12 the possible physical, developmental, educational, and psychosocial
- 13 outcomes.
- 14 (ii) The options available for treatment and therapy for
- 15 conditions related to Down syndrome.
- 16 (iii) Projected life expectancies for individuals with Down
- 17 syndrome.
- 18 (iv) Contact information for support services for individuals
- 19 with Down Syndrome and their caregivers, including information
- 20 hotlines specific to Down syndrome, resource centers, local and
- 21 national Down syndrome organizations, and other education,
- 22 advocacy, and support programs for Down syndrome.
- 23 (c) Is culturally and linguistically appropriate for a
- 24 caregiver of an individual with Down syndrome.
- 25 (3) The department of health and human services shall annually
- 26 update the written information described under subsection (2) and
- 27 shall make the information available on the department's website.
