## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 272. (1) For the following tax years that begin after
- 2 December 31, 2007, a A taxpayer may credit against the tax imposed
- 3 by this act an amount equal to the specified percentages of the
- 4 credit the taxpayer is allowed to claim as a credit under section
- 5 32 of the internal revenue code for a tax year on a return filed
- 6 under this act for the same tax year:
- 7 (a) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2007 and

- 1 before January 1, 2009, 10%.
- 2 (b) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2008 and
- **3** before January 1, 2012, 20%.
- 4 (c) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2011 and
- 5 before January 1, 2023, 6%.
- 6 (d) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2022 and
- 7 before January 1, 2024, 15%.
- 8 (e) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2023 and
- 9 before January 1, 2025, 20%.
- 10 (f) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2024 and
- 11 before January 1, 2026, 25%.
- 12 (g) For tax years that begin after December 31, 2025 30%.
- 13 (2) If the credit allowed by this section exceeds the tax
- 14 liability of the taxpayer for the tax year, the state treasurer
- 15 shall refund the excess to the taxpayer without interest, except as
- 16 provided in section 30 of 1941 PA 122, MCL 205.30.
