A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 495 (MCL 168.495), as amended by 2018 PA 603.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 495. The registration application must contain all of the following:
- 3 (a) The name of the elector.
- 4 (b) The residence address of the elector, including the street

- 10 the affidavit, or will be on the date of the next election, not
- 11 less than 18 years of age.
- 12 (h) A statement that the elector has or will have lived in
- 13 this state not less than 30 days before the next election.
- (h) (i) A statement that the elector has or will have
- 15 established his or her the elector's residence in the township or
- 16 city in which the elector is applying for registration not less
- 17 than 30 days before the next election.
- (i) (j) A statement that the elector is or will be a qualified
- 19 elector of the township or city on the date of the next election.
- 20 (j) (k)—A space in which the elector shall state the place of
- 21 the elector's last registration, if any.
- (k) (l)—A statement that the registration is not effective
- 23 until processed by the clerk of the city or township in which the
- 24 applicant resides.
- 25 (l) $\frac{\text{(m)}}{\text{A}}$ statement that the applicant, if qualified, may vote
- 26 at an election occurring on or after the date of completing the
- 27 application.
- 28 (m) (n) A statement authorizing the cancellation of
- 29 registration at the elector's last place of registration.

(n) A statement that the elector understands that it is a felony to offer to vote or attempt to vote more than once at the same election either in the same or another voting precinct.
