A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

(MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594) by adding section 364.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 364. (1) A house of the legislature shall not pass an appropriations bill that includes a legislatively directed spending item unless all of the following requirements are met:
- 4 (a) The legislatively directed spending item is sponsored by a 5 legislator.

- 1 (b) The sponsoring legislator provides a written statement
- 2 that contains all of the following information to the chairs of the
- 3 senate and house of representatives appropriations committees, the
- 4 senate and house fiscal agencies, and the legislative council:
- 5 (i) The sponsoring legislator's name.
- 6 (ii) The name and location of the intended recipient or, if
- 7 there is not an intended recipient, the intended location of the
- 8 project or activity.
- 9 (iii) The purpose of the legislatively directed spending item
- 10 and an explanation of why the legislatively directed spending item
- 11 is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds.
- 12 (iv) A description of any community support.
- 13 (v) A certification that neither the sponsoring legislator nor
- 14 the sponsoring legislator's immediate family has a direct or
- 15 indirect pecuniary interest in the legislatively directed spending
- 16 item.
- 17 (c) The written statement has been available to the public on
- 18 the internet as described in subsection (2) for not less than 48
- 19 hours.
- 20 (2) The legislative council shall make each written statement
- 21 received under subsection (1) available to the public on the
- 22 internet as soon as practicable after the receipt of the
- 23 information.
- 24 (3) As used in this section:
- 25 (a) "Community support" includes, but is not limited to, all
- 26 of the following:
- 27 (i) A letter of support from an elected community leader.
- 28 (ii) A press article highlighting the need for the funding.
- 29 (iii) Support from a newspaper editorial board.

- 1 (iv) A community development plan or other publicly available
 2 planning document that includes the item for which funding is
 3 sought.
- 4 (v) A resolution passed by the governing body of a community.
- 5 (b) "Immediate family" means an individual's parent, child, 6 sibling, and spouse and a relative of any degree residing in the
- 7 same household as that individual.

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- 8 (c) "Legislative council" means the legislative council
 9 created under the legislative council act, 1986 PA 268, MCL 4.1101
 10 to 4.1901.
- 11 (d) "Legislatively directed spending item" means an 12 appropriation that authorizes or obligates a specific amount of 13 money for a contract or other expenditure with or a grant, loan, or 14 other economic assistance or incentive to a person, unit of local 15 government, or project or activity in a unit of local government, 16 other than through a formula-driven or competitive award process. 17 An appropriation may be a legislatively directed spending item 18 regardless of whether the allocation of the appropriation is based 19 on population figures or whether the appropriation has a private or 20 local purpose. Legislatively directed spending item includes, but
- 22 infrastructure grants.

is not limited to, Michigan enhancement grants and Michigan

- 23 (e) "Legislator" means a person duly elected and serving in 24 the Michigan house of representatives or the Michigan senate.
- 25 (f) "Sponsoring legislator" means the legislator who sponsors 26 a legislatively directed spending item under subsection (1)(a).
