- 1 A resolution to declare April 23-April 29, 2023, as
- 2 Infertility Awareness Week in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, According to the Centers for Disease Control and
- 4 Prevention, 1 in 8 couples have trouble getting pregnant or
- 5 sustaining a pregnancy; and
- 6 Whereas, The World Health Organization and American Medical
- 7 Association define infertility as a disease; and
- 8 Whereas, Infertility affects women and men equally and does
- 9 not discriminate based on race, religion, sexual orientation,

- 1 marital status, or socioeconomic status; and
- 2 Whereas, The LGBTQ+ community also faces challenges when
- 3 building their families; and
- 4 Whereas, All people facing infertility challenges should have
- 5 access to all family building options; and
- 6 Whereas, Family building options include adoption and medical
- 7 treatment, such as in vitro fertilization and third-party
- 8 reproduction; and
- 9 Whereas, Cost and lack of insurance coverage are barriers for
- 10 many to access the family building option they need; and
- 11 Whereas, Racial and socioeconomic disparities exist among
- 12 those accessing fertility care, therefore raising awareness of
- 13 infertility and the barriers faced by the family building community
- 14 is the first step to removing these barriers; and
- 15 Whereas, Michigan joins the National Infertility Association
- 16 and dedicated volunteers, health care professionals, and members of
- 17 the infertility and family building community by participating in
- 18 this promotion; now, therefore, be it
- 19 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 20 this legislative body declare April 23-29, 2023, as Infertility
- 21 Awareness Week in the state of Michigan.
