- 1 A resolution to recognize May 2023 as Neurofibromatosis
- 2 Awareness Month.
- 3 Whereas, Although over two million people around the world are
- 4 living with neurofibromatosis (NF) and one in every 3,000 births is
- 5 diagnosed with NF, it is still relatively unknown to the public;
- 6 and
- 7 Whereas, NF affects all populations equally, regardless of
- 8 race, ethnicity, or gender; and
- 9 Whereas, NF causes tumors to grow on nerves throughout the
- 10 body and also can affect development of the brain, cardiovascular

- 1 system, bones, and skin. The disorder can also lead to blindness,
- 2 deafness, bone abnormalities, disfigurement, learning disabilities,
- 3 disabling pain, and cancer; and
- 4 Whereas, The Children's Tumor Foundation (CTF) leads efforts
- 5 to promote and financially sponsor world-class medical research
- 6 aimed at finding effective treatments and, ultimately, a cure for
- 7 NF; and
- 8 Whereas, CTF works to improve access to quality patient
- 9 healthcare through its national NF Clinic Network and provides
- 10 patient and family support through its information resources, youth
- 11 programs, and local chapter activities; and
- 12 Whereas, Much remains to be done in raising public awareness
- 13 of NF to help promote early diagnosis, proper management and
- 14 treatment, prevention of complications, and support for research;
- 15 now, therefore, be it
- 16 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 17 body recognize May 2023 as Neurofibromatosis Awareness Month.
