Rep. Churches offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare March 1, 2023, as Endometriosis 2 Awareness Day in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, Endometriosis is a disease of the female reproductive system. Endometriosis occurs when tissue similar to that normally 4 found in the uterus begins to grow outside of the uterus, leading 6 to chronic, debilitating pelvic pain; and 7 Whereas, Endometriosis is a leading cause of female 8 infertility. Endometriosis affects 1 in 10 women between the ages of 15 and 44 in the United States. There is an average of a 10 year 9 delay from the onset of symptoms to the final diagnosis of 10 11 endometriosis; and 12 Whereas, American endometriosis patients were hospitalized

- 1 105,123 days in 2010 because of their disease. Women with
- 2 endometriosis can lose 11 hours per work week through lost
- 3 productivity and absenteeism due to pain. Fifty-one percent of
- 4 endometriosis patients report that their condition detrimentally
- 5 affects their job; and
- 6 Whereas, The estimated total annual societal burden of
- 7 endometriosis-related symptoms in the U.S. is \$56 billion, or
- **8** \$10,824 per patient; and
- 9 Whereas, There is no cure for endometriosis. More research is
- 10 necessary to develop treatment options to manage this debilitating
- 11 disease. Education is important for promoting awareness of symptoms
- 12 and early detection and diagnosis of endometriosis; and
- 13 Whereas, Endometriosis Awareness Day is the period of time
- 14 when people recognize the impact of this disease on women's health
- 15 and well-being, and understand that more work must be done to
- 16 mitigate negative impacts of endometriosis; now, therefore, be it
- 17 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 18 this legislative body declare March 1, 2023, as Endometriosis
- 19 Awareness Day in the state of Michigan. We recognize the
- 20 significant impacts of this disease on women's health outcomes.
