## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.55

Senator Nesbitt offered the following resolution:

A resolution to recognize May 2023 as Neurofibromatosis
 Awareness Month.

3 Whereas, Although over two million people around the world are
4 living with neurofibromatosis (NF) and one in every 3,000 births is
5 diagnosed with NF, it is still relatively unknown to the public;
6 and

7 Whereas, NF affects all populations equally, regardless of8 race, ethnicity, or gender; and

9 Whereas, NF causes tumors to grow on nerves throughout the
10 body and also can affect development of the brain, cardiovascular
11 system, bones, and skin. The disorder can also lead to blindness,
12 deafness, bone abnormalities, disfigurement, learning disabilities,

1 disabling pain, and cancer; and

2 Whereas, The Children's Tumor Foundation (CTF) leads efforts
3 to promote and financially sponsor world-class medical research
4 aimed at finding effective treatments and, ultimately, a cure for
5 NF; and

6 Whereas, CTF works to improve access to quality patient
7 healthcare through its national NF Clinic Network and provides
8 patient and family support through its information resources, youth
9 programs, and local chapter activities; and

Whereas, Much remains to be done in raising public awareness of NF to help promote early diagnosis, proper management and treatment, prevention of complications, and support for research; now, therefore, be it
