AN ACT to set certain minimum standards for fire departments in certain municipalities; and to provide a time within which they must comply.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

123.831 Fire departments in cities of 70,000; minimum standards.

Sec. 1. In each city, township or village which has or shall hereafter attain a population of 70,000 or more according to the last decennial census, the fire department shall meet the minimum standards set by the Michigan inspection bureau to qualify for class 6 fire classification.

123.832 Time within which standards must be met.

CALLINATION And may contain out dated in formation. This document out dated in formation. Sec. 2. These minimum standards shall be met within 1 year from the effective date of this act or within 1 year from the date the municipality attains a population of 70,000 or more.
