SUMMARY OF SENATE BILL 876 as introduced 5-19-88:

The bill would amend Public Act 261 of 1966, which provides for the apportionment of county boards of commissioners, to require that the term of each commissioner, who was elected after December 31, 1988, be concurrent with the terms of State senators, as specified in the State Constitution. The bill would take effect January 1, 1989.

Currently, commissioners' terms are concurrent with the terms for State representatives, as specified in the State Constitution.
