## ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 146

AN ACT to amend section 1 of Act No. 188 of the Public Acts of 1913, entitled "An act relating to the conduct of hotels, inns and public lodging houses," being section 427.1 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 188 of the Public Acts of 1913, being section 427.1 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. For purposes of this act, "hotel" means a building or structure kept, used, maintained as, or held out to the public to be an inn, hotel, or public lodging house. Hotel does not include a bed and breakfast as defined in section 12901 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being section 333.12901 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
