

HOUSE BILL No. 4645

May 18, 1987, Introduced by Reps. Brown, Gubow, Perry Bullard, Hoffman, DeBeaussaert, Gire, Scott, Fitzgerald, Bandstra, Stabenow, Hollister and Emerson and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended
"The Michigan liquor control act,"
as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 24a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra
2 Session of 1933, as amended, being sections 436.1 to 436.58 of
3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 24a to
4 read as follows:

5 SEC. 24A. IN EVERY ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS LICENSED TO SELL
6 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES, THERE
7 SHALL BE POSTED A SIGN THAT WARNS AGAINST DRINKING ALCOHOL DURING
8 PREGNANCY. THE LANGUAGE APPEARING ON THE SIGN SHALL BE APPROVED
9 BY THE COMMISSION, SUBJECT TO THE ADVICE AND CONSULTATION OF THE

1 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH. THE LOCATION AND DIMENSIONS OF THE
2 SIGN SHALL BE PRESCRIBED BY RULE OF THE COMMISSION.
