

# HOUSE BILL No. 4885

June 29, 1987, Introduced by Reps. DeBeaussiaert, Sikkema, Gire, Hickner, Browne, Gubow, Varga, Perry Bullard, Bennett, Scott, Watkins, Sofio, Barns, Kosteva, Leland, Dobronski, Emerson, Ciaramitaro, Munsell, DeMars, Brown, Jondahl, Hollister and Trim and referred to the Committee on Public Health.

A bill to amend section 10 of Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled  
"Pesticide control act,"  
being section 286.560 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 10 of Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of  
2 1976, being section 286.560 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4       Sec. 10. (1) The director may refuse to register or may  
5 cancel or suspend registration of a pesticide if:

6       (a) A pesticide does not warrant the proposed claims for it  
7 or if the pesticide and its labeling and other material required  
8 to be submitted do not comply with this act or the rules  
9 promulgated under this act. The applicant shall be notified of  
10 the manner in which the pesticide, labeling, or other material

1 required to be submitted fails to comply with this act. If, upon  
2 receipt of the notice, the applicant does not make the required  
3 changes within 30 days, the director may refuse to register the  
4 pesticide.

5 (b) A registered pesticide is in violation of this act or  
6 rules promulgated under this act, or presents an imminent  
7 hazard.

8 (2) FOLLOWING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT  
9 ADDS THIS SUBSECTION, THE DIRECTOR SHALL NOT REGISTER THE PESTI-  
10 CIDE COMMONLY KNOWN AS CHLORDANE AND SHALL CANCEL ANY REGISTRA-  
11 TION IN EFFECT FOR THAT PESTICIDE.
