

HOUSE BILL No. 5369

February 11, 1988, Introduced by Reps. Keith and O'Neill and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, entitled

"The state school aid act of 1979,"

as amended, being sections 388.1601 to 388.1772 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 148.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 94 of the Public Acts of 1979, as
2 amended, being sections 388.1601 to 388.1772 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 148 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 148. (1) FROM THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 11,
6 THERE IS ALLOCATED AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$170,000,000.00 FOR
7 1988-89 TO APPLICANT DISTRICTS THAT INSTITUTE AN EDUCATION
8 QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION. EACH

1 DISTRICT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE UNDER THIS SECTION AN AMOUNT PER
2 PUPIL DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

3	DISTRICT'S STATE EQUALIZED	AMOUNT OF STATE
4	<u>VALUATION PER PUPIL</u>	<u>AID PER PUPIL</u>
5	LESS THAN \$40,000.00	\$150.00
6	\$40,000.00 TO \$54,999.00	\$125.00

8	\$75,000.00 TO \$84,999.00	\$ 75.00
9	\$85,000.00 TO \$89,999.00	\$ 50.00
10	\$90,000.00 OR MORE	\$ 25.00

11 (2) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION, A DIS-
12 TRICT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT ON A FORM AND IN A MANNER
13 REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT EVIDENCE OF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

14 (A) THE DISTRICT PROVIDES TO ALL K TO 12 PUPILS ATTENDING
15 PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE DISTRICT A CORE CURRICULUM THAT INCLUDES, AT
16 A MINIMUM, ALL SUBJECTS AND INFORMATION THAT THE DEPARTMENT REC-
17 OMMENDS BE TAUGHT AT THEIR GRADE LEVEL.

18 (B) THE DISTRICT HAS ADOPTED A TESTING PROGRAM APPROVED BY
19 THE DEPARTMENT TO MEASURE IF THE GOALS OF THE DISTRICT'S CORE
20 CURRICULUM ARE BEING ACHIEVED.

21 (C) THE DISTRICT HAS INSTITUTED A PLAN TO ENSURE THAT NOT
22 LATER THAN THE START OF THE 1992-93 SCHOOL YEAR THE AVERAGE CLASS
23 SIZE OF GRADES K, 1, 2, AND 3 IS NOT MORE THAN 20 PUPILS.

24 (D) THE DISTRICT HAS SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT A 3-TO
25 5-YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN THAT WAS DEVELOPED BY PARENTS,
26 TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, AND BUSINESS AND LABOR LEADERS FOR EACH
27 SCHOOL WITHIN THE DISTRICT.

1 (E) IF FEASIBLE, THE DISTRICT HAS GIVEN EACH PARENT AND
2 LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A CHILD RESIDING WITHIN THE DISTRICT THE
3 OPPORTUNITY TO SELECT FROM ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS WITH AN APPROPRIATE
4 GRADE LEVEL WITHIN THE DISTRICT THE PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT HIS OR HER
5 CHILD WILL ATTEND.

6 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
7 all of the following bills of the 84th Legislature are enacted
8 into law:
