

# SENATE BILL No. 24

January 29, 1987, Introduced by Senator SEDERBURG and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend section 18212 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended  
"Public health code,"  
being section 333.18212 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 18212 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1978, being section 333.18212 of the Michigan Compiled Laws,  
3 is amended to read as follows:

4       Sec. 18212. (1) ~~After the period prescribed in section~~  
5 ~~+8211(+)~~ EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), an  
6 individual shall not engage in postdoctoral training which  
7 includes the practice of psychology without obtaining a full or  
8 limited license to practice under this part.

9       (2) A limited license for an individual in postdoctoral  
10 training shall require that the individual be under supervision

1 of a licensed psychologist and confine his or her practice and  
2 training to a hospital, clinic, institution, or other arrangement  
3 approved by the board for the training. The hospital, clinic, or  
4 institution and designated licensed psychologist are responsible  
5 for the training. A limited license for a postdoctoral training  
6 is renewable for not more than 5 years.

7 (3) THE MICHIGAN BOARD OF PSYCHOLOGY SHALL WAIVE THE  
8 REQUIREMENT OF HAVING A LIMITED LICENSE IN ORDER TO ENGAGE IN THE  
9 POSTDOCTORAL EXPERIENCE NECESSARY TO OBTAIN A FULL LICENSE IF ALL  
10 OF THE FOLLOWING OCCUR:

11 (A) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS MET ALL THE OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF  
12 SUBSECTION (2).

13 (B) THE INDIVIDUAL PAYS A SUM EQUAL TO THE COST OF A LIMITED  
14 LICENSE.

15 (C) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS APPLIED FOR A LICENSE BETWEEN JULY 1,  
16 1985 AND JULY 1, 1986.
