

SENATE BILL No. 57

February 17, 1987, Introduced by Senator MACK and referred to the
Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend chapter III of Act No. 165 of the Public
Acts of 1929, entitled as amended
"Michigan sportsmen fishing law,"
as amended, being sections 303.1 to 303.11 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 1b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Chapter III of Act No. 165 of the Public Acts of
2 1929, as amended, being sections 303.1 to 303.11 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1b to read as
4 follows:

6 SEC. 1B. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION IN THIS ACT OR
7 ANY ORDER OF THE COMMISSION OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR THE DIRECTOR
8 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS
9 SHALL BE APPLICABLE DURING THE OPEN SEASON FOR TROUT IN THAT

1 PORTION OF DUCK CREEK WITHIN GOGEBIC COUNTY, WATERSMEET TOWNSHIP,
2 BEGINNING AT THE OLD RAILROAD BRIDGE SE-SE SECTION 16, T44N-R39W
3 DOWNSTREAM TO THE MIDDLE BRANCH OF THE ONTONAGON RIVER AT NW-NW
4 SECTION 27, T45N-R39W:

5 (A) ONLY ARTIFICIAL LURES MAY BE USED TO TAKE TROUT.

6 (B) TROUT MUST BE AT LEAST 10 INCHES IN LENGTH.

7 (C) NOT MORE THAN 5 TROUT MAY BE TAKEN PER DAY.
