- 4 Sec. 3. The magistrate's finding of reasonable or probable
- 5 cause shall be based upon all the facts THE TOTALITY OF THE
- 6 CIRCUMSTANCES related within the affidavit made before him OR
- 7 HER. The affidavit may be based upon reliable information
- 8 supplied to the complainant from a credible person, named or
- 9 unnamed, so long as the affidavit contains affirmative
