

SENATE BILL No. 196

April 1, 1987, Introduced by Senator CRUCE and referred to the
Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend chapter XI of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts
of 1895, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of cities of the fourth
class; to provide for the vacation of the incorporation thereof;
to define the powers and duties of such cities and the powers and
duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor
agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to
provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money,
and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by
cities; to define the application of this act and provide for its
amendment by cities subject thereto, and to validate such prior
amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by
such cities,"

as amended, being sections 91.1 to 91.9 of the Michigan Compiled
Laws, by adding section 1a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Chapter XI of Act No. 215 of the Public Acts of
2 1895, as amended, being sections 91.1 to 91.9 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1a to read as
4 follows:

1 CHAPTER XI

2 SEC. 1A. A LIBRARY ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 1 SHALL NOT

3 CHARGE A FEE FOR THE LOAN OF ANY LIBRARY MATERIALS.
