

SENATE BILL No. 549

November 10, 1987, Introduced by Senators SCHWARZ, DE GROW, SMITH,
DI NELLO, CARL, POLLACK and EHLERS and referred to the Committee
on Education and Mental Health.

A bill to amend section 1204 of Act No. 451 of the Public
Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

being section 380.1204 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1204 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
2 of 1976, being section 380.1204 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1204. (1) The board of a school district shall make an
5 annual report to the state board at the time and in the form pre-
6 scribed by the board.

7 (2) NOT LATER THAN JULY 1, 1990, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DIS-
8 TRICT SHALL PREPARE AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC AN ANNUAL
9 EDUCATIONAL REPORT. THE ANNUAL EDUCATIONAL REPORT SHALL INCLUDE,
10 BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1 (A) AN EXPLANATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CORE
2 CURRICULUM REQUIRED BY SECTION 1277.

3 (B) A REPORT OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT BASED UPON THE RESULTS
4 OF ANY LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED STUDENT COMPETENCY TESTS, STATEWIDE
5 SUBJECT MATTER ASSESSMENT TESTS, OR NATIONALLY NORMED ACHIEVEMENT
6 TESTS THAT WERE GIVEN TO PUPILS ATTENDING SCHOOL IN THE
7 DISTRICT.

8 (C) FOR THE CURRENT AND PREVIOUS SCHOOL YEAR, THE NUMBER AND
9 PERCENTAGE OF PUPILS IN THE DISTRICT, IDENTIFIED BY GRADE LEVEL,
10 WHO QUIT SCHOOL.

11 (D) FOR THE CURRENT AND PREVIOUS SCHOOL YEAR, THE NUMBER OF
12 PUPILS, IDENTIFIED AT THE ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, AND SECONDARY
13 SCHOOL LEVELS, WHO ARE ENROLLED IN SCHOOL IN THE DISTRICT.

14 (E) THE PERCENTAGE OF PUPILS WHO GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL
15 IN THE DISTRICT, 1, 3, AND 5 YEARS AFTER GRADUATION, WHO ARE
16 ENROLLED IN VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS, COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGES, AND
17 4-YEAR COLLEGES OR UNIVERSITIES.

18 (F) STATISTICAL INFORMATION, TO THE EXTENT KNOWN, ON THE
19 TYPES OF JOBS HELD BY PUPILS WHO GRADUATED FROM HIGH SCHOOL IN
20 THE DISTRICT 1, 5, AND 10 YEARS AFTER GRADUATION, AND THE NUMBER
21 AND PERCENTAGE OF GRADUATES, IDENTIFIED BY CHOICE AND BY CIRCUM-
22 STANCE, WHO ARE UNEMPLOYED.

23 (G) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE STATE BOARD MAY REQUIRE.

24 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

26 of the 84th Legislature is enacted into law.
