- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 4m to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 4M. A PERSON SUBJECT TO TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE
- 5 FROM GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX THE VALUE
- 6 OF MEALS PROVIDED TO THE PERSON'S EMPLOYEES, IF THE PERSON IS
- 7 ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF PREPARING AND SELLING FOOD OR
- 8 BEVERAGES FOR DIRECT CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES.
