

SENATE BILL No. 786

March 22, 1988, Introduced by Senators CRUCE, EHLERS, DE GROW,
GEO. HART, POLLACK and FAUST and referred to the Committee
on State Affairs, Tourism, and Transportation.

A bill to amend Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949,
entitled as amended
"Michigan vehicle code,"
as amended, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 633a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as
2 amended, being sections 257.1 to 257.923 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 633a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 633A. A PERSON SHALL NOT OPERATE A VEHICLE UPON A
5 HIGHWAY OR STREET OF THIS STATE IF THE VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH A
6 DEVICE WHICH IS DESIGNED TO DETECT THE ELECTROMAGNETIC WAVE SPEC-
7 TRUM SURVEILLANCE OF SPEED BY A POLICE OFFICER. A PERSON WHO
8 VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CIVIL INFRACTION AND THE

1 DEVICE DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONFISCATED BY THE
2 POLICE OFFICER.
