

# SENATE BILL No. 794

April 12, 1988, Introduced by Senators SHINKLE and FESSLER and referred to the Committee on State Affairs, Tourism, and Transportation.

A bill to authorize the department of natural resources to convey certain state owned property located in Lenawee county; and to prescribe conditions for the conveyance.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. The department of natural resources, on behalf of  
2 the state, may convey to the drain commissioner of Lenawee  
3 county, Michigan, for consideration of \$1.00, 2 parcels of land  
4 described as follows:

5       A part of the west 1/2 of sec. 25 and the east 1/2 of  
6 sec. 26 T5S-R2E, Cambridge twp. Lenawee county, Lot numbers 2 and  
7 6 of the Waterford subdivision in the Lake Loch Erin project.

8       Sec. 2. The description of the parcel in section 1 is  
9 approximate and may be adjusted as considered necessary by the  
10 department of management and budget.

1       Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by  
2 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general.

3       Sec. 4. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide  
4 that the land shall be used exclusively for public drainage  
5 related purposes.

6       Sec. 5. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide  
7 that the state shall retain and reserve to the state all mineral  
8 rights.

9       Sec. 6. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-  
10 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
