

SENATE BILL No. 876

May 19, 1988, Introduced by Senators CROPSEY, EHLERS and DI NELLO
and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend section 10 of Act No. 261 of the Public Acts
of 1966, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the apportionment of county boards of commissioners; to prescribe the size of the board; to provide for appeals; to prescribe the manner of election of the members of the county board of commissioners; to provide for compensation of members; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

being section 46.410 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 10 of Act No. 261 of the Public Acts of
2 1966, being section 46.410 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 10. The term of each commissioner ELECTED AFTER
5 DECEMBER 31, 1988 shall be concurrent with that of state
6 ~~representatives~~ SENATORS as specified in SECTION 2 OF article
7 IV ~~4, section 3~~ of the state constitution OF 1963.

1 Section 2. This amendatory act shall take effect January 1,
2 1989.
