## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 310 of Act No. 150 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1967, being section 32.710 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3:0. The adjutant general shall be the military advi-
- 5 sor to the governor and -may SHALL be the director of the
- 6 department of military affairs. His THE ADJUTANT GENERAL'S
- 7 office shall be maintained in Lansing. He is authorized to THE
- 8 ADJUTANT GENERAL MAY publish orders and other directives in the
- 9 name of the governor and the state to implement and administer
- 10 -his THE duties and responsibilities as outlined in this

- I statute. His ACT. THE ADJUTANT GENERAL'S duties shall include
- 2 maintenance of the personnel records of all persons, active,
- 3 inactive, retired, and deceased of the state military establish-
- 4 ment; liaison in the transaction of official business for the
- 5 state with the United States and for this state with other states
- 6 and territories, including those duties devolving upon -him THE
- 7 ADJUTANT GENERAL pursuant to the national defense act and other
- 8 pertinent federal laws and regulations. -He- THE ADJUTANT
- 9 GENERAL shall maintain records of claims for state gratuities for
- 10 military service rendered by citizens of this state and, when
- 11 authorized by the legislature, shall receive, examine, process,
- 12 and recommend the payment of gratuities in accordance with law.
- 13 -He- THE ADJUTANT GENERAL shall be entitled to use the coat of
- 14 arms of Michigan with the words added "State of Michigan,
- 15 Department of Military Affairs" as his THE seal of office. All
- 16 copies of orders, records, and papers certified and authenticated
- 17 under such seal shall be equivalent in evidence to the
