## **HOUSE BILL No. 4044**

January 31, 1991, Introduced by Rep. Bennett and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Forestry and Minerals.

A bill to require the labeling of fruits and vegetables sold, offered for sale, or distributed for consumption in this state; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Department" means the department of agriculture.
- 3 (b) "Labeled" means a display of written, printed, or
- 4 graphic material upon a fruit or vegetable or upon the immediate
- 5 container of the fruit or vegetable.
- 6 (c) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 7 association, the state, or any other public or private entity.

- 1 (d) "Pest" means that term as defined in section 6 of the 2 pesticide control act, Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of 1976,
- 3 being section 286.556 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 4 (e) "Pesticide" means a substance or mixture of substances
- 5 intended for preventing, destroying, repelling, or mitigating
- 6 pests, or intended for use as a plant regulator, defoliant, or
- 7 desiccant.
- 8 (f) "Plant regulator" means a substance or mixture of sub-
- 9 stances, intended through physiological action, for accelerating
- 10 or retarding the rate of growth or rate of maturation, or for
- 11 otherwise altering the behavior of plants or the produce of
- 12 plants, but shall not include substances to the extent that they
- 13 are intended as plant nutrients, trace elements, nutritional

- 15 Sec. 2. (1) All fruits and vegetables sold, offered for
- 16 sale, or distributed for consumption in this state shall be
- 17 labeled in a manner approved by the department. The label shall
- 18 list each of the following:
- 19 (a) The name of each pesticide used in the production of the
- 20 fruit or vegetable.
- 21 (b) The name of each chemical substance used in the produc-
- 22 tion of the fruit or vegetable that is listed in rules promul-
- 23 gated as provided in subsection (2).
- 24 (2) The department shall promulgate rules pursuant to the
- 25 administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public
- 26 Acts of 1969, being sections 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan
- 27 Compiled Laws, listing chemical substances other than pesticides

- I that shall be included on labels required under this act. In
- 2 determining which chemical substances to require on a label, the
- 3 department shall include all substances that have an adverse

- 5 Sec. 3. (1) A person who violates this act shall pay to the
- 6 state a civil fine of not less than \$5,000.00 per violation.
- 7 (2) A default in the payment of a civil fine or costs
- 8 ordered under this act or an installment of the fine or costs may
- 9 be remedied by any means authorized under the revised judicature
- 10 act of 1961, Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, being sec-
- 11 tions 600.101 to 600.9947 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 12 Sec. 4. Fruits and vegetables that are sold, offered for
- 13 sale, or distributed for consumption in this state that are not
- 14 labeled as required by this act and rules promulgated under this
- 15 act are subject to confiscation and destruction by the department
- 16 of agriculture.
