- 2 resources CONSERVATION AND RECREATION, and 4 residents of the
- 3 state to be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent
- 4 of the senate.
- 5 (3) The terms of the appointive members shall be 4 years,
- 6 except that of those first appointed, 1 shall be appointed for 1
- 7 year, 1 shall be appointed for 2 years, 1 shall be appointed for
- 8 3 years, and 1 shall be appointed for 4 years.
- 9 (4) The appointive members may be removed by the governor
- 10 for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office.
