THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 "records media act".
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) Except to the extent limited by law, if a gov-
- 4 ernmental entity or a governmental official acting in his or her
- 5 official capacity reproduces a record, the reproduction may be
- 6 created using any of the following media, subject to subsection

- 1 (d) Optical storage disc, as of the effective date of rules,
 2 to be promulgated pursuant to subsection (2), that govern optical
 3 storage discs.
- 4 (2) Pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969,
 5 Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, being sections 24.201 to
 6 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the department of state and
 7 the department of management and budget shall jointly promulgate
 8 rules setting forth standards that govern the creating, process9 ing, indexing, storage, retrieval, durability, and inspection of
 10 reproductions by a governmental entity or governmental official
 11 acting in his or her official capacity. With respect to optical
 12 storage disc systems, the standards shall require logical and

- 14 Sec. 3. With respect to a reproduction created by a person 15 other than a governmental entity or a governmental official 16 acting in his or her official capacity, a law that references 17 this act incorporates by reference any medium that correctly and 18 accurately reproduces the original.
