HOUSE BILL No. 4540

March 13, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Hood, Richard A. Young, Harrison, Emerson and Bennane and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans' Affairs.

A bill to provide free tuition at state public institutions of higher education for dependents of Michigan residents serving in Operation Desert Storm; and to provide for an appropriation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "Operation Desert Storm tuition act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of military affairs.
- 5 (b) "Dependent" means an individual who can be claimed as a 6 dependent under the internal revenue code.
- 7 (c) "Michigan Operation Desert Storm serviceperson" means 8 either of the following:
- 9 (i) A resident of this state who is on active duty in the 10 Michigan national guard or the United States armed forces reserve 11 and who was ordered to active duty after August 2, 1990.

- (ii) A resident of this state who is on active duty in the
 regular United States armed forces serving in an area designated
 as a combat zone by the President of the United States.
- 4 (d) "State institution of higher education" means a public
- 5 community or junior college established under section 7 of arti-
- 6 cle VIII of the state constitution of 1963 or part 25 of the
- 7 school code of 1976, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976,
- 8 being sections 380.1601 to 380.1607 of the Michigan Compiled
- 9 Laws, or a state university described in section 4, 5, or 6 of
- 10 article VIII of the state constitution of 1963.
- 11 Sec. 3. A state institution of higher education shall waive
- 12 tuition for each dependent of a Michigan operation desert storm
- 13 serviceperson if the dependent meets all of the following
- 14 requirements:
- (a) Applies and qualifies for admission as a full-time,
- 16 part-time, or summer school student.
- (b) Is a legal resident of the state for not less than the
- 18 12 consecutive months before applying.
- (c) Applies to the department for tuition waiver under this
- 20 act and provides evidence satisfactory to the department that he
- 21 or she is the dependent of a Michigan operation desert storm
- 22 serviceperson and that he or she meets the other requirements of

- 24 Sec. 4. Upon application by the institution, the department
- 25 shall reimburse annually each state institution of higher educa-
- 26 tion for the total amount of tuition waived during the
- 27 immediately preceding fiscal year under section 3. The

- 1 department shall report annually to the legislature the number of
- 2 individuals for whom tuition has been waived at each institution
- 3 and the total amounts to be paid under this act.
- 4 Sec. 5. The department shall provide the necessary forms
- 5 and applications and shall cooperate with the state institutions
- 6 of higher education in developing efficient procedures for imple-
- 7 menting this act.
- 8 Sec. 6. The legislature shall appropriate annually the
- 9 funds necessary to implement this act.
