

# HOUSE BILL No. 4661

March 27, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Profit, Weeks, Yokich, Bouchard, McNutt, DeMars, Law, Byrum, Allen, Harrison, Martin and Anthony and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931,  
entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 479b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as  
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 479b to read as follows:

4       SEC. 479B. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE ON A  
5 PUBLIC HIGHWAY OR OTHER PLACE GENERALLY ACCESSIBLE TO MOTOR VEHI-  
6 CLES WHO KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW THAT HE OR SHE HAS BEEN  
7 DIRECTED BY A POLICE OFFICER OR CONSERVATION OFFICER TO STOP THAT  
8 MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL STOP THAT MOTOR VEHICLE AS DIRECTED BY THAT  
9 POLICE OR CONSERVATION OFFICER.

1       (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) BY EXCEEDING  
2 THE SPEED LIMIT BY MORE THAN 30 MILES PER HOUR OR OPERATING THAT  
3 MOTOR VEHICLE IN RECKLESS DISREGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF ANY INDIVIDUAL  
4 IS GUILTY OF A FELONY, PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT  
5 MORE THAN 4 YEARS, OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR  
6 BOTH. AN INDIVIDUAL CONVICTED OF A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION  
7 OF THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND SHALL BE PUNISHED  
8 BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT LESS THAN 30 DAYS OR MORE THAN 4  
9 YEARS, OR A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$500.00 OR MORE THAN \$2,000.00,  
10 OR BOTH. THE COURT SHALL ORDER THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO REVOKE  
11 THE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE OF AN INDIVIDUAL  
12 CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS SUBSECTION.

13       (3) A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS OPERATED IN VIOLATION OF  
14 SUBSECTION (2) IS SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE.
