A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 286 of the Public Acts of 1964, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the organization, powers, and duties of the state transportation commission and the state transportation department; to provide for the appointment, powers, and duties of the state transportation director; to abolish the office of state highway commissioner and the commissioner's advisory board and to transfer their powers and duties; to provide for penalties and remedies; and to repeal certain acts and parts of act,"

being section 247.803 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 286 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1964, being section 247.803 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 3. The governor with the advice and consent of the
- 5 senate shall appoint the first members of the commission for
- 6 terms of 1, 2, 3, and 4 years, commencing on July 1, 1964.

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- 1 Except for terms commenced before the effective date of section
- 2 6a, the term of office of a member of the commission shall be for
- 3 3 years. ONE MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE FROM THE UPPER
- 4 PENINSULA OF THIS STATE. Vacancies on the commission shall be
- 5 filled by the governor for the unexpired terms. A MAJORITY OF
- 6 THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE REQUIRED TO CONSTITUTE A
- 7 QUORUM. THE COMPENSATION OF THE COMMISSION AND THE SCHEDULE FOR
- 8 REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES SHALL BE ESTABLISHED ANNUALLY BY THE
- 9 LEGISLATURE. Each member shall give to the people of the state a
- 10 bond in the penal sum of \$25,000.00, with sureties approved by
- 11 the state treasurer, conditioned upon the faithful discharge of
- 12 the duties of his or her office, the premium to be paid from the
- 13 -state MICHIGAN transportation fund.
- 14 Section 2. Section 354 of the executive organization act,
- 15 Act No. 380 of the Public Acts of 1965, being section 16.454 of
- 16 the Michigan Compiled Laws, is repealed.

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
