- 7 MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL POLICY UNTIL DECEMBER 31 OF THE CALENDAR
- 8 YEAR IN WHICH THE CHILD BECOMES 25 YEARS OF AGE REGARDLESS OF
- 9 WHETHER OR NOT THE CHILD IS CONSIDERED A DEPENDENT UNDER
