

HOUSE BILL No. 5659

March 9, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Harrison and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend Act No. 115 of the Public Acts of 1991,
entitled

"An act to make appropriations for the department of natural resources for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; to provide for the expenditure of those appropriations; to create funds and accounts; to require reports; to prescribe certain powers and duties of certain state departments and officers, institutions, and agencies; to authorize certain transfers by certain state agencies; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the various state agencies,"

by adding section 602a; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 115 of the Public Acts of 1991 is
2 amended by adding section 602a to read as follows:

3 SEC. 602A. OF THE FUNDS APPROPRIATED IN SECTION 101 FOR
4 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE AND PLANNING, \$600,000.00 IS FOR A
5 LOCAL RECREATION GRANTS PROGRAM, AND OF THIS AMOUNT, \$10,000.00
6 SHALL BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE VILLAGE OF HANOVER. THESE FUNDS

1 SHALL NOT BE ENCUMBERED OR EXPENDED UNTIL THE DEPARTMENT DEVELOPS
2 GUIDELINES FOR THE PROGRAM.

3 Section 2. Section 602 of Act No. 115 of the Public Acts of
4 1991 is repealed.
