

# HOUSE BILL No. 5668

March 9, 1992, Introduced by Rep. Harrison and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the department of agriculture for affirmative action in the office of racing commissioner for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

1       Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of agriculture  
2 to supplement former appropriations for the fiscal year ending

# 11 GENERAL SECTIONS

12       Sec. 201. (1) In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of  
13 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending in  
14 this appropriation act is \$47,200.00 and state appropriations to be paid  
15 to local units of government in section 101 are \$0.

16       (2) When it appears to the principal executive officer of each  
17 department that state spending to local units of government will be less  
18 than the amount that was projected to be expended for any quarter, the  
19 principal executive officer shall immediately give notice of the appro-  
20 priate shortfall to the department of management and budget, the senate  
21 and house appropriations committees, and the senate and house fiscal  
22 agencies.

23       Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under  
24 this act and the departments, agencies, commissions, boards, offices, and  
25 programs for which an appropriation is made under this act are subject to  
26 the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984,  
27 being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
