

# HOUSE BILL No. 5689

March 11, 1992, Introduced by Reps. Perry Bullard, Pitoniak, Gubow, Bandstra, Fitzgerald, Jondahl, Clarke, Wozniak, Griffin, Emerson, Saunders, Niederstadt and Weeks and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 22 of Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of 1985, entitled as amended

"Crime victim's rights act,"

being section 780.772 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 22 of Act No. 87 of the Public Acts of  
2 1985, being section 780.772 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 22. (1) Upon the request of a victim, the prosecuting  
5 attorney shall, within 30 days of the final disposition of the  
6 case, notify the victim in writing of the final disposition of  
7 the case.

8 (2) IF A DEFENDANT APPLIES TO HAVE A CONVICTION FOR A CRIME  
9 AGAINST THE PERSON SET ASIDE UNDER ACT NO. 213 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS  
10 OF 1965, BEING SECTIONS 780.621 TO 780.624 OF THE MICHIGAN

1 COMPILED LAWS, THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY SHALL NOTIFY THE VICTIM  
2 OF THE CRIME AGAINST THE PERSON IN WRITING OF THE APPLICATION AND  
3 FORWARD A COPY OF THE APPLICATION TO THE VICTIM. THE VICTIM HAS  
4 THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY PROCEEDING UNDER ACT NO. 213 OF  
5 THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1965 CONCERNING THAT CONVICTION. AS USED IN  
6 THIS SUBSECTION, "CRIME AGAINST THE PERSON" MEANS A CRIME THAT IS  
7 AN ASSAULTIVE CRIME AS DEFINED IN SECTION 9A OF CHAPTER X OF THE  
8 CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, ACT NO. 175 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF  
9 1927, BEING SECTION 770.9A OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.

10 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
11 Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 5688 (request  
12 no. 04692'91) of the 86th Legislature is enacted into law.
